do therefore certify to all whom it doth or may concern
that by the last Will and Testament of a certain
Benjamin Blunt, duly executed on the 10th day of
September in the year 1811, and proved in my
Office on the 22nd day of October in the same year, a
certain Negro Man named Caleb, five feet six inches
and one half of an inch in height, complexion black
a scar just above the left eye brow, flat nose, thick
lips, heavy eyes, bushy hair usually wears whiskers,
was manumitted and set free by the last Will and
Testament of the said Benjamin Blunt; his freedom
to commence in twelve years from the first day of January
next after the execution of the, last Will & Testament
of the said Benjamin Blunt after ^{said} his person identified by a
certain Tho CO Hopper. Given under my hand and
the Seal of my Office this 8th day of June Anno
domini Eighteen hundred & twenty four
