of freedom, under an Act of the General Assembly
of Maryland, passed at November Session 1805
I do therefore certify to all whom it doth or may
concern, that by the last Will & Testament of a certain
Philip Tiddeman, duly executed on the 18th day
of July in the year 1821 and proved in my Office
on the 22^d day of January 1822, a certain Negro
Man named Saul, of a dark complexion, five
feet three inches and a half in height, a scar on
the inside of the right arm near the elbow joint,
a scar on his left cheek, when he laughs shews
his upper fore teeth and gums very much, was manu-
-mitted and set free by the last Will & Testament of
the said Philip Tiddeman, his freedom to commence
on the first day of January next following the decease
of the said Philip Tiddeman. His person identified
by a certain Philip Henry Tiddeman, the Executor
of the last Will & Testament of the said Philip Tiddeman
