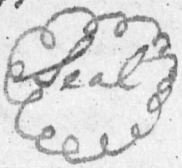

last Will & Testament of the said Arthur Emory; her

Office, this 27th day of Oct Anno Domini 1825

Edmond Trarrell, duly executed on the 19 day of July
1810 and proved in my Office on the 16 day of July in
the same year, there is a bequest to his wife Elizabeth~~
