Last Will and Testament of a certain Geo Medford
duly executed on the 17th day of September 1825, and
proved in my Office on the 22^d day of Oct in the same
year, a certain Negro Man named George, five feet
six & one fourth inches in height, complexion dark, nearly
approaching to black, the middle finger of his left
hand injured, a small scar on the fore finger of his
right hand, and slight scar near the corner of his
right eye, was manumitted and set free by the last-
will & Testament of the said Geo Medford - His freedom
to commence on the 1st day of Jan'y 1826 - His person
identified by a certain W^m Medford, who is the Executor
of the last will and Testament of the said Geo Medford

a certain Negro Man named Charles, had made
application to me for a certificate of freedom, under
an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed
at November Sessions 1805. I do therefore Certify to all
whom it doth or may concern, that by the last-will
and Testament of a certain Sarah Bettons, duly execu-
ted on the 20th day of Jan'y 1810 and proved in my Office
on the 4th day of March 1811, a certain Negro Boy named
Charles, five feet five inches in height, of a dark
complexion, a slight scar on the joint of the middle
finger of the left hand, a small round spot, about
the size of a pea, nearly on the cap of his right
