Mr. McKinnell, from the committee on internal improvement, reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and for the completion of the Baltimore and Susquehanna Rail Road to the borough of York, in the State of Pennsylvania.

Mr. Townsend reported a bill, entitled, an act relating to free negro and mullatto children.

Mr. Hillen reported a bill, entitled, an act relating to the lien of mechanics and others upon buildings.

Mr. Matthews reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to abolish the office of commissioners of the tax for Charles county;

And Mr. Neff reported a bill, entitled, an act for the advancement of justice, and the convenience of the people of this State,

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Shower, entitled, an act to grant a donation to the Deer Park Academy, in Carroll county,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the senate.
