

Mr. Carroll, chairman of the committee on education, to which was referred the bill reported by Mr. Huddleson, entitled, an act for the promotion of education in Allegany county, by means of the poor school fund in said county, reported the same with the following amendments:—

Amendments proposed.

2d section, 14th line, after the word "commissioners," insert "of Allegany county."

Same section, strike out all after "respectively," in the 22d line.

Strike out the 4th section of the bill.

Which were read.

The bill reported by Mr. McDaniel, from the committee on corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the Lombard Hotel Company,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and sent to the senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Ristean, entitled, an act to amend the constitution and form of government of this State,

Was taken up for consideration.*

On motion of Mr. Ristean, said bill was amended by inserting after the word "any," in the 1st section, second line, the words "judges or,"—and after the word "State," in the same line and section, by inserting "except justices of the peace."

On motion of Mr. Ristean, said bill was further amended by inserting in 2d section, second line, after the word "accept," the words "of hold," and after the word "appointment," the words "or office."

Mr. Giles moved further to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following:—

"Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall have no force and effect unless, and until it be confirmed by the next General Assembly of Maryland, after publication in the manner now provided for a change in the constitution of this State."

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Alexander moved to recommit said bill and amendments,

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Duke moved to refer said bill and amendments to the committee on the constitution,

Determined in the negative.
