Also, the bill, entitled, an act for the establishment of a civil municipal jurisdiction over a part of Anne Arundel county, to alter and change the constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same,—severally endorsed “will pass with the proposed amendments,”

Which amendments were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Ely presented a memorial of the President and Directors of the Maryland Hospital, praying assistance of the State for the promotion of the benevolent object of that institution,

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Parran reported a bill, entitled, an act to provide for the compensation of the crier of Calvert county court,

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Jones, entitled, an act for the benefit of Samuel G. Holbrook, of Somerset county, and

The bill reported by Mr. Goldsborough, entitled, an act for the relief of Reubin Tall, former sheriff and collector of Dorchester county,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Powder, entitled, an act to authorise the laying out and opening a new road through a part of Anne Arundel and Carroll counties,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Brown, said bill was recommitted.

The bill reported by Mr. Coombs, entitled, an act for the regulation of gates on the public roads in Prince George's and Charles counties,

Was taken up for consideration.

On motion of Mr. Hughes, said bill was laid on the table.

Mr. Ely reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to provide for the erection of a bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder at Tyson's mill, in Baltimore county, passed at December session 1836, ch. 195,

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Williams, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Harford county, to settle certain claims therein mentioned;

The bill also reported by Mr. Williams, entitled, an act to authorise the building of a bridge over Bynum's Run, in Harford county;

And the bill reported by Mr. Frazier, from the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce James Weston, of Talbot county, from his wife Ann I. Weston,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and severally passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Williams, entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Harford county to cause a certain property therein named to be assessed and taxed for its just proportion of the county charges.
