

Mr. Biser obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled an act to change the compensation of judges and clerks of elections, so far as relates to Frederick county;

Ordered, that Messrs. Biser, Geyer, and Ent report the same.

Mr. Giles obtained leave to bring in a bill, to provide for the appointment of commissioners out of the State of Maryland, to take the acknowledgements of deeds and instruments of writing under seal;

Ordered, that Messrs. Giles, Alexander and Kerr, report the same.

Mr. Blocher obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled a further supplement to an act, passed at December session 1835, chapter 305;

Ordered, that Messrs Blocher, Huddleson, and Sprigg report the same.

Mr. Crane obtained leave to bring in a bill, to regulate fences in Saint Mary's county;

Mr. Sollers obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act, relating to the repairs of public roads in Calvert county;

Mr. Powder obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act to repeal so much of an act, entitled, an act to provide for making a new and complete map and Geological survey of this State, passed December session, 1833, chapter 138, as relates to the appointment of a Geologist;
