So the amendment was rejected.

On motion of Mr. Williams, said bill was amended by adding at the end of the second section the following—"and the burthen of proof as to the fact of insolvency shall be upon the bank refusing to receive such issues as aforesaid."

Mr. Carroll then moved to amend said 2d section by striking out all after the words "and each shall," to the end of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following—"during their common suspension receive at par, the issues of all banks of the State that may have complied with the provisions of the third section of this act."

Which was read.

On motion of Mr. Ely, said amendment was amended by striking out the word "common."

The question then recurred upon the amendment as amended.

On motion of Mr. Bowie, said amendment was further amended by adding at the end thereof these words—"and the burthen of proving any such non compliance shall be on the bank refusing to receive said issues."

The question again recurred and was put upon the amendment as amended, and

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. Causin then moved to strike out the second section of the bill,

Determined in the negative.
