Determined in the negative.

Mr. Boyle, of Carroll, called for the year and nays, which call was not sustained by the house.

Mr. Townsend called for the previous question, that is, shall the main question be now put, and it was

Resolved in the affirmative.

The question was then put-Shall the said bill pass?

Resolved in the affirmative.
