Also, the bill, entitled, an act for the better regulation of the banking institutions in this State;

Endorsed 'will pass with the proposed amendments;'

Which amendments were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Also, the resolution in favor of the Rev. Mr. McElhiney and Rev. Mr. Vinton;

Also, the resolution relative to the distribution of the school fund in Harford county;

Also, the resolution in favor of Battle Creek Academy;

Severally endorsed, 'assented to,' and the resolutions severally ordered to be engressed.

And, delivered the following bills, originated in and passed by

the senate—viz:

A bill, entitled, an additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act to reduce into one the several acts of Assembly respecting elections; and to regulate said elections, passed at December session, 1832, ch. 275;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. White, Berret, Sprigg.

Mann and Geyer.

A bill, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs of Thomas Hilleary, late of Montgomery county, deceased;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time,

and passed.

Also, a resolution relative to McMahon's Maryland;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time and assented to.

The bill from the senate, entitled, a further supplement to an act to provide for electing commissioners for Baltimore county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at Dec. session, 1826, ch 217, and the amendments reported thereto from the select committee;

Were taken up for consideration;

The amendments having been read the second time, were assented to.

The said bill was then read the second time and passed with

the proposed amendments.

The bill reported by Mr. Turner, of Baltimore county, entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of a committee to review and decide upon a suitable site for a bridge over the Great Falls of Gunpowder, in Baltimore county, in the 13th election district in said county,—and

The bill reported by Mr. Parker, entitled, a supplement to an act to provide for electing commissioners for Cecil county by districts, and prescribing their powers and duties, and repealing an act and its supplements therein mentioned, passed at Dec. session,

1831, ch. 164;

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.
