The clerk of the senate returned the said bills, severally endorsed, read and assented to.

And delivered the engrossed bills of the senate, from number two hundred and seven to number two hundred and twenty six inclusive,

Which were severally read, assented to, and returned to the senate.

A deputation from the senate being announced, Messrs. Bowie and Goldsborough, members of that body, appeared within the bar of the house and informed the speaker that his Excellency, the Governor, was attending in the senate chamber and requested the attendance of this house to see him sign and seal the laws.

The speaker left the chair, and attended by the members of this house, went to the senate chamber and there presented the engrossed bills to the Governor who signed the same, and affixed the great seal thereto in the presence of both houses, from No. 94 to No. 226 inclusive.

The speaker with the rest of the members returned and resumed the chair.

The bill reported by Mr. Berret, entitled, an act directing the commissioners of the tax of Carroll county to publish annually a full statement of their receipts and disbursements:
