We herewith return you the resolution relating to the bond of State printer, in accordance with the request in your message.

Mr. Hillen moved that the house take up for consideration the bill reported by him, entitled, an act relating to the lien of mechanics and others upon buildings;

Determined in the negative.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the silk company of Somerset county;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act for the valuation of the real and personal property in Harford county;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Mining, Manufacturing and Rail Road Company of Hibernia;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act for the preservation of passengers and prevention of accidents on the several rail roads in this State;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act for the benefit of William Walker, a minor in the State of Georgia,

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to authorise Juliet Done to bring into this State her slave Jane;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to prevent the destruction of wild fowl in the head waters of the Chesapeake bay in the several counties therein mentioned, passed at December session 1837;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to prohibit the transportation of absconding slaves to Hayti or elsewhere, passed at December session 1824, ch 85;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Susquehanna Boom Company;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act for the appointment of commissioners to designate a place of election in the Salisbury district, in Somerset county;

Also, the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the alteration and improvement of certain streets in Salisbury, in Somerset county;

And the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to divorce Ann Hunt, of Anne Arundel county, from her husband Henry Hunt,

Were severally taken up for consideration, read the second time, severally rejected, and returned to the senate.

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to authorise the register of the Land Office of the Western Shore to issue a warrant of resurvey and patent for certain lands in Allegany county,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time, passed and returned to the senate.
