

Which was read.

On motion of Mr. Causin,

Ordered, that the clerk of the house furnish the clerk to the special committee on the currency, with copies of all the orders which have been or may hereafter be referred by this house to that committee.

Mr. Blocher submitted the following resolution:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Executive be directed to deliver to Capt. Thos. Dowden sixty stand of muskets, with all the necessary accoutrements, for the use of the "Cumberland Guards," now under his command, he giving bond with security as required by law for their safe keeping and return to the State.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time and assented to.

Mr. Dawson from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, made an unfavorable report upon the order of the house, requiring them to enquire into the expediency of revising and reducing into one, the several enactments in relation to landlord and tenant, so far as relates to Frederick county;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Causin, from the committee on grievances and courts of justice, entitled, an act supplemental to an act, entitled, an act to establish Magistrate's courts in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction, was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Causin, said bill was recommitted.

Mr. Blocher reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to an act, entitled, an act for the preservation and repair of that part of the United States Road within the limits of the State of Maryland;

Mr. Ford, chairman of the committee on the constitution, reported a bill, entitled, an act to confirm an act, entitled, an act to amend the constitution and form of government of the State of Maryland, passed at December session, 1836, chap. 197;—And,

Mr. Turner, of Baltimore county, reported a bill, entitled, an act to release John Jones from confinement in Baltimore county jail;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Sprigg reported a bill, entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned;
