

Mr. Iglehart, submitted the following resolution.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby directed, to pay to the order of Adam Houk, the son in law of the late Eleanor L. Mayhugh, the sum of eight dollars, for 2 months and 12 days pension, due to the said Eleanor L. Mayhugh on the 12th December 1837, the day of her death.

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and assented to.

Mr. Hughes, chairman of the committee on coloured population, to which was referred the bill reported by Mr. Causin, entitled, an act to authorise John Milburn, to bring into this State negro man Nace, a slave for life, reported the same with the following amendment;

Amendment proposed.

Strike out all after the word "provided," and insert the following, "that within thirty days after such removal, the said John Milburn, shall cause to be recorded in the office of the clerk of Saint Mary's county court, the name, age, and sex, of the said negro slave so removed;"

Which was read,

The amendment having been read the second time by special order, was assented to.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended and passed.

Mr. Hughes, chairman of the committee on coloured population, to which was referred the bill reported by him, entitled, an act to authorise William Penn, to bring into this State, a negro slave for life; reported the same with the following amendment;

Amendment proposed.

At the end of the bill add the following proviso;

"Provided also that at or before the time of making such record the said William Penn, shall pay to the clerk of said court, the sum of fifteen dollars, to be paid over by said clerk to the treasurer of the Western Shore, for the use and benefit of the Colonization society of the State,"

Which was read.

The said amendment having been read the second time by special order, was assented to;

The said bill was then read the second time as amended and passed.

Mr. Turner, of Baltimore county, reported a bill, entitled, an act to define the duties of sheriffs, coroners or elisors, so far as relates to Baltimore county; and

Mr. Risteau, chairman of the committee on divorces, reported a bill entitled, an act to divorce Mary Corner, of Dorchester county, from her husband Solomon Corner;

Which were severally read the first and by special order the second time and passed.
