Amend the title of the bill by striking out the words "of the State of Maryland," and insert the words "of the District of Columbia".

At the end of the title add, "of the city of Baltimore."

The committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to confirm an act entitled, an act providing for the appointment of clerks of the several county courts, the clerks of the Courts of Appeals for the Eastern and Western Shores, the clerk of Baltimore city court and the Registers of Wills in the several counties of this State, was enlarged and made to consist of Messrs. Kent, Goldsborough, Bruce, Lee and Beckett.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Silk Company of Kent county, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,
