

A resolution authorising the librarian to subscribe for a certain number of a compilation of the laws, to be prepared by the Honorable Clement Dorsey;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the library.

A resolution relative to the digest of the laws.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the better regulation of Chancery proceedings in certain cases, passed at December session 1820, chapter 161, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act empowering and authorising the Rector and Vestry of Saint Mark's Parish in Frederick county, to receive a deed of conveyance therein mentioned, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

The Senate adjourned until Monday morning ten o'clock.

MONDAY, February 26, 1838.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on Saturday
The proceedings of Saturday were read.

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Carroll county academy and house of public worship, was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Goldsborough submitted the following message; which was read and adopted:

By the Senate,
February 26, 1838.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

We have received your message proposing that on this day, the Speaker of the House of Delegates and the President of the Senate shall proceed to perform the duty enjoined on them by that provision of the constitution which directs that the numerical order of the gubernatorial districts shall be fixed by lot, and we respectfully suggest to your honorable body the propriety of postponing that ceremony until all pending legislation in regard to the office of Governor shall have been consummated.
