The clerk of the house of delegates returned said bills, endorsed "read and assented to," and delivered the engrossed bills of the house of delegates, from No. 1 to No. 73 inclusive,

Which were read and assented to.

His Excellency Governor Veazey, appeared in the Senate Chamber.

On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

It was ordered, that Messrs. Ricaud and Tidball, be appointed a deputation to wait on the honorable the house of delegates, and inform them His Excellency the Governor is now in the Senate Chamber, prepared to sign the laws passed by the present General Assembly, and request their attendance to witness the ceremony. Messrs. Ricaud and Tidball retired, and after a time returned and reported, that they had discharged the duty assigned them.

The Honorable Speaker and members of the house of delegates appeared in the Senate Chamber, when His Excellency Governor Veazey, signed and sealed the engrossed bills from No. 1 to No. 93 inclusive, in the presence of the General Assembly, in conformity with the requirements of the constitution and form of government.

The Honorable Speaker and members of the house of delegates

retired.

His Excellency the Governor, also retired.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning ten o'clock.

## THURSDAY, March 1, 1838.
