A bill entitled, an act to divorce James H. Knotts of Queen Ann's county, from his wife Catherine Knotts,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on

divorces.

A bill entitled, an act to confirm and make valid a deed of conveyance from Joseph L. Smallwood to George S. Adams,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on

invalid deeds and defective proceedings.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to prevent the unnecessary accumulation of costs in civil suits, passed at December session 1825, chapter 167, endorsed "will pass."

Also returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Maryland and New York Iron and Coal Com-

pany, endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments,

Which amendments were read and assented to, and were as follows:

1st. In the 4th section and 13th line, strike out the words "they shall deem" and insert "may be."

2nd. In 5th section 3d line, after the word "place," insert "within

this State."

3d. In the 8th line same section, strike out 'ten' and insert 'thirty.'

4th. In the 6th section 11th line, after the word "purposes" insert, "provided that no such borrowing of money shall imply a right to borrow or purchase the stock of the State, or any other description of property whatever."

5th. In same line same section, after the word "act," insert, "and

more particularly the fifteenth section thereof."

6th. At the end of the 7th section add:

"Or small note for circulation of any kind whatever."

7th. At the end of the 9th section add:

"Provided, that the General Assembly may at any time, order proceedings to vacate this charter, if the same shall be violated."

8th. Ald as an additional section:

"And be it enacted, That a common writ, warrant or other precept, served upon any member or against said company, shall be as effectual as if such writ, warrant or other precept had been served upon the President and Directors of said company."

On motion of Mr. Brown,

The bill entitled, an act to provide for electing commissioners for Carroll county, and prescribing their powers and duties, was reconsidered, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.
