NEGATIVE.

Messrs. Bruce, Kent, Lee, Tidball and Wright,—5.

So it was determined in the affirmative

Mr. Bruce from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mining, Manufacturing and Rail Road Company.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Cottman from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the heirs of William Brown, late of Carroll county deceased,

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The Senate adjourned until Monday morning ten o'clock.

Mr. Beckett from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the encouragement of primary schools in Calvert county, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to.

Same section 3d line, instead of the word "board" insert "number;" after the word "of" same line, insert "school;" fourth line, strike out
