

Last line, 1st section, after the word "dollars," strike out the words "nor the land exceed ten thousand acres."

9th sec. 9th line, after the word "road," insert the words, "with the rail road."

Same section, 18th line, after the word "thereof," strike out the word "and," in 19th line.

10th section, 4th line, after the word "therein," strike out to the end of the section.

Strike out the 12th section and insert the following,

And be it enacted, That if the said company hereby incorporated, shall not, within the term of five years from and after the passage of this act, locate and construct the rail road or rail roads authorized by the fifth and ninth sections of this act, then, and in that case, all power and authority vested in said company, to locate and construct said rail road or rail roads, shall cease and determine, any thing in this act, to the contrary notwithstanding."

The bill was read through, and,

On motion of Mr. Jones,

Amended as follows:

Add, as an additional section,

"And be it enacted, That nothing in this act contained shall authorise the said company to exercise banking privileges, or to issue any note in the nature of a bank note or certificate of deposit, payable to bearer; or shall in any manner interfere with the corporate privileges conferred upon the Chesapeake and Ohio canal and the Baltimore and Ohio rail road companies."

The bill was then ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution in favor of the securities of Marcy Fountain on his collector's bond or bonds,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Hambleton, Goldsborough and Wright.

Also, a bill entitled an act to amend the constitution and form of government of this State,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Tidball and Cotman.

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

The bill entitled an additional supplement to the act entitled an act to reduce into one the several acts of assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections, passed at December session, 1832, chapter 275, was recommitted to the committee who reported it.

Mr. Purnell, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled an act to authorise the laying out and opening a road in Worcester county, therein mentioned, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
