A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Bank of Allegany,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations.

A bill entitled, an act to compensate the crier of Montgomery county court,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bowie, Kent and Lee.

A bill entitled, an act to provide for electing commissioners for Frederick county, and prescribing their powers and duties,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Lee, Tidball and Bruce.

A bill entitled, an act to provide for the compensation of the crier of Calvert county court,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Kent, Bowie and Jones.

A bill entitled, an act regulating damages in cases of suits for trespass done by stock, so far as relates to Baltimore county, and

A bill entitled, an act in relation to the stock formerly held by the Bank of Maryland in certain Turnpike road companies,

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Carroll White Sulphur Spring Company in Allegany county, and

A bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Calvert Beneficial Society of Baltimore, passed at December session 1836,

Which were severally read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Sally Anne Porter of Talbot county, from her husband James Porter,
