

The bill entitled an act to divorce James J. Pattison, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife, Eleanor Pattison, was taken up for consideration, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

The bill entitled an act relating to promissory notes and bills of exchange was read the third time, by special order, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

The bill entitled an act for the preservation of passengers and prevention of accidents on the several rail roads of this State, was read the second time, by special order, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and,

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

Read the third time, by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Cottman, from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the petition of S. M. Simmes, reported a bill entitled an act to confirm a certain deed therein mentioned;

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and,

On motion of Mr. Cottman,

Read the third time, by special order, passed, and sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled a supplement to an act for regulating and inspecting weights and measures used in this State, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled a supplement to an act entitled an act to incorporate Woodsboro', in Frederick county, passed at December session, 1836, chapter 299, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Tidball from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill entitled a further supplement to the act entitled an act for the despatch of business in Baltimore county court, passed at December session, 1828, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Kent, from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled an act to regulate the inspection of tobacco in Prince George's county, reported favorably thereon.
