Messrs. Brown, (Pres't pro tem.) Cottman, and Purnell—3.

So it was determined in the affirmative, and the bill returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act authorising Charles Carroll of Anne Arundel county, to bring into this State, certain negroes, slaves for life, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill which had been made the order of the day for Saturday last the 24th inst, entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to reduce into one the several acts of Assembly respecting elections and to regulate said elections, passed at December session 1832, chapter 275,

It was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

Read the third time by special order, and the question put,

“Shall the bill pass?”

The yeas and nays were asked for and on taking them they appeared as follows:

AFFIRMATIVE.

NEGATIVE.

Messrs. Brown, (Pres't pro tem.) Beckett, Bowie, Jones, and Purnell,—5.

So it was determined in the affirmative, and the bill sent to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Purnell from the committee on finance, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the better regulation of the Banking Institutions of this State, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to.

In the 4th line of the 2d section, after the word “therein,” strike out to the end of the section.

In the 1st line of the 3d section, after the word ‘state,’ insert the words, ‘during the suspension of specie payments.’

The bill was being read the second time, when,

On motion of Mr. Jones,

The following amendments were read and assented to:

In the 2d line of the 4th section, strike out from the word ‘coin’ to the word ‘within,’ in the 3d line.

In the 5th line of the same section, strike out the words ‘should they resume specie payments previous to said day.’
