The committee appointed by the Senate to confer with the committee appointed on the part of the House of Delegates, in relation to the amendments of the Senate, to the bill entitled, an act for the better regulation of the Banking Institutions in this State, beg leave

to report:

That your committee have conferred with the committee of the House of Delegates, and the committee of conference have agreed to recommend to the respective houses, that the first amendment to said bill, proposed by the Senate, be adopted by the house; that the second amendment of the Senate, be also adopted by the house, and that the said section be further amended by adding thereto the following words—"and after the resumption, shall not exceed the amount of their capital actually paid in" That the third and fourth amendments of the Senate be receded from by the Senate, and that the fifth amendment of the Senate be adopted by the house.
