and to repeal part of an act therein mentioned.

Mr. Ricaud from the committee on invalid deeds and defective ptoceedings, to which was referred the petition of Richard Ringgold, praying the passage of an act to make valid a deed therein mentioned, reported a bill entitled, an act to make valid a certain instrument of writing therein named and for other purposes,

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and

ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

Read the third time by special order; passed and sent to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Ricaud.

The following order was read and adopted:

Ordered, That Nathaniel F. Williams, Esquire, be and he is hereby appointed State Director on the part of the Senate in the Bank of Baltimore, for the ensuing year.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered the following

resolutions:

A resolution requiring the sheriff of Allegany county, to pay over to the Treasurer of the poor school fund of said county, the amount forfeited by the securities of Samuel Warwick,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on

finance.

A resolution directing His Excellency the Governor, to cause to be delivered to captain Thomas Dowden, two hundred stand of muskets, accoutrements, &c.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on the

militia.

Also the following bills:

A bill entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned, Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on invalid deeds and defective proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to change the compensation of judges and

clerks of elections, so far as relates to Carroll county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Tidball,

Bowie and Goldsborough.

A bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties of this State and to prescribe their jurisdiction, so far as the same relates to Somerset county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Purnell,

Hambleton and Wright,

A bill entitled, a further supplement to an act to provide for electing commissioners for Baltimore county and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session 1826, chapter 217,
