197. An act to divorce Frederica Meyer, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband George Meyer.

198. An act to authorise the laying out and opening a road in Worcester county, therein mentioned.

199. An act to divorce William R. Sheffield, of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Mary Elizabeth Sheffield.
