In the 4th line of the 1st section, strike out the word "county" and insert "counties."

In the 5th line of the same section, after the word "Allegany," insert the words "and Cecil."

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

The bill was ordered to lie on the table.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on

corporations.

A bill entitled, an act for the preservation of wild fowl in the waters of Smith's Island and its vicinity, in Somerset county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Cottman,

Goldsborough and Wright.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Jay of Washington county, from her husband William Jay,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on

divorces.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate entitled, an act to incorporate the Chester Silk Company, endorsed "will pass."

The bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Law Buildings Company of Baltimore, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading,
