And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, an act to authorise the more safe and profitable investment by the Levy court of Worcester county, of a part of the Free School Funds of said county, and for other purposes, endorsed "will pass."

Mr. Goldsborough submitted the following message; which was

The bill was then read the second time.

Mr. Jones from the committee on corporations, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Washington Lyceum of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Jones from the committee on internal improvement to which was referred the bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act for the preservation and repair of the United States Road within the limits of the State of Maryland, reported that the committee were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendments,

Which were read and assented to:

Sec. 1, 3d and 4th lines, strike out the words 'between the west base of Savage mountain in Allegany county, and the termination of said road in the town of Cumberland,' and insert 'within the limits of the State of Maryland, going and returning on the same day.'

Sec. 2, strike out in 2d line, after the word 'in,' the word 'the' and

insert 'one or more of the.'
