WEDNESDAY, February 7, 1838.

The Senate met. Present the same Senators as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act to limit the time for which Tobacco Inspectors shall continue to hold their offices, passed December session 1836, chapter 122, passed by the Senate on yesterday with an amendment, was returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Brown from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to authorise Bennett Gilbert, administrator of Preston McComas late sheriff of Harford county, to settle the unfinished business of said late sheriff, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to confirm an act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government as relates to the division of Washington county into eight separate election districts, and for other purposes, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to divorce Horatio R. Merryman of the State of Maryland, from his wife Sarah A. Merryman, was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an act relating to the record of the proceedings of the convention which established the declaration of rights and the constitution and form of government of this state, was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

It was accordingly engrossed, and

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

Read the third time by special order, passed and sent to the house of delegates.

The bill entitled, an act to abolish the Levy court, provide for the appointment of commissioners of Somerset county, and prescribing their duties, was read the third time, passed and sent to the house of delegates.
