The bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to reduce into one the several acts of Assembly respecting elections and to regulate said elections, passed at December session 1832, chapter 275, was being read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Tidball,

It was ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Wright from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for building a Bridge over Little Elk creek, near the Rock Meeting House in Cecil county, on the main road leading from Dysart's Tavern, to the Blue Ball Tavern, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Brown presented the memorial of Emeline W. Noble, for a divorce from her husband Nathaniel G. Noble,

Which was read and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Wright from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, an act to lay out and open a new road in Cecil county, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second and by special order the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.
