A bill entitled, an act to make valid the election of Jonathan Rienthart, as a county commissioner of Allegany county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Bruce, Tidball and Lee.

A bill entitled, an act directing that the rules of the several courts in this State, be published for the information of the people,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society, of the Maryland Annual Conference,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of John Clippenger of Washington county,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvency.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise Robert W. Harper, of Prince George's county, to carry with him to the State of Mississippi, a certain negro who is a slave for a term of years,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on colored population.

A bill entitled, an act for the relief of John Beard, junr. collector of the tax for the first collection district in Anne Arundel county,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Brown, Beckett and Tidball.

A bill entitled, an act for the condemnation of a lot of ground for a public landing in St. Mary's county,
