

Sec. 2, And be it enacted, That the Mayor of the city of Baltimore, be and he is hereby authorised to designate stands for the inspection and measurement of lime, and to establish such and so many as in his judgment the public convenience may require, and the said inspectors and their deputies shall change their stands alternately on the Monday of each week.

Sec. 3, And be it enacted, That all the lime manufactured within the limits of the city or which may be brought to the city for sale or intended to be used therein, shall be taken to one of the stands designated by the Mayor, and there be submitted for inspection, when required on the same day on which it is to be sold, to be inspected and measured by the person appointed as aforesaid, who shall measure and inspect the same in the waggon, car, cart or other carriage in which it is brought, agreeably to the standard hereafter mentioned, and give to the seller a certificate of the quality and quantities thereof, that is, whether it be first, second or third quality—for which certificate, he shall be entitled, to receive as a compensation, thirty-seven and a half cents.

Sec. 4, And be it enacted, That all lime manufactured within the limits of the city and put up in casks or other vessels, and all the lime brought to the said city in casks or other vessels, by water or otherwise, for sale or intended to be used therein, shall be measured and inspected in the same manner, the quantity and quality marked with a Webb brand on the cask or other vessel containing the same, and for every cask or other vessel so inspected and measured, the inspector shall be entitled to receive six and one quarter cents, as his compensation, and all lime manufactured within the limits of the city or brought to the city, whether by land or water, which in the judgment of the inspector, is below the standard of third quality, shall be condemned and thus mentioned in the certificate given by the inspectors, and also marked on the cask or other vessel; and it is hereby further enacted, that it shall not be lawful for any person or persons residing in the city of Baltimore, to sell or dispose of any lime in barrels, casks or other vessels which shall not have been first inspected and branded by some one of the inspectors appointed under this act; and that any person or persons so selling or disposing of any lime in barrels, casks or other vessels, not branded by some one of the said inspectors, shall forfeit for each and every offence, the sum of ten dollars, to be recovered as a common debt, before some justice of the peace in the said city—one half to be paid to the informer, and the other half into the city Treasury.

Sec. 5, And be it enacted, That any person selling or buying lime not measured and inspected as aforesaid, shall forfeit and pay ten dollars for every offence—to be recovered as a common debt, before some justice of the peace in said city, one half to be paid to the informer and the other half into the city Treasury.

Sec. 6, And be it enacted, That if any waggoner, driver or own-
