I hereby certify that the bearer hereof, of a bright Yellow complexion five feet two and a quarter inches high considerably freckled square made pleasant countenance, became free by virtue of a manumission from William Wilson dated on the 26th May 1818 and recorded in Liber MD No. 1 folio 347 one of the land record books of Harford County Court and is now about forty five years of age and was raised in Harford County.
