a chestnut coloured complexion, five feet four and
a quarter of an inch in height with a scar on the

Deed of Manumission from Mary Preston a free coloured
woman bearing date on the first day of September
1837 - and recorded among the Land Record Books of
Harford County Court -

of Manumission duly executed by Rebecca Appnell to
Negro Sylvia. ~~and~~ in and about the Year Eighteen
hundred and five, and recorded in Liber H. D. N. S. folio
32 one of the Land Record Books of Harford County Court
