Maryland Harford County to wit: I hereby certify that the bearer hereof ^{Negro} Matilda Brooks, aged ^{about} twenty five years of dark complexion, about five feet two inches and a half high, with a large indistinct scar on the left cheek caused by a burn, & two small scars one above and the other below ^{was born free and} the right eye, is the daughter of Negro Violet who was manumitted by Daniel Moores, and was ~~born free~~

Negro Charles Lee Cato Brooks

Maryland Harford County to wit: I hereby certify that the bearer hereof Negro Charles Lee Cato Brooks, aged about twenty one years, of ^{very dark} complexion, about five feet ten inches high, with a scar in the inside of his elbow caused by a burn, was born free and is the son of Negro Violet who was manumitted by Daniel Moores.
