With a scar on his face near his under jaw
and a scar on his left arm just below the
Elbow, and the first joint of his little finger
Crooked on her left hand of a yellow Com-
plexion aged about thirty five years became
free by Will of a manumission Decanted
by Nancy B. Brown on the Eighteenth day
of June 1828 and recorded in Office of the Clerk
of Harford County Court on the 23rd day of June

Negro Roderick Lewis

Maryland Harford County to Wit —
I hereby Certify that the slave hereof Negro Lewis is
five feet one and a half inches high & of a yellow
Complexion. With a scar on his left shoulder
aged about twenty two years. Was bound to me and

my hand and affixed the seal of my office the 14th day of 1828
