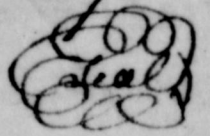
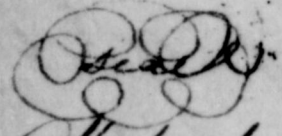


State of Maryland, Sherrif Certify to all persons

 person manumitted by William Harrison on the 29<sup>th</sup> day

 that the bear hereof Jane Stanford, a bright Mul-  
 latio, about thirty years of age, five feet four inches  
 and one half high, has several scars on her left arm  
 occasioned by burns, and also has a mark, on the  
 said arm, is the identical manumitted by his  
 Father William Harrison, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May 1809.

State of Maryland, Talbot County, to wit. Sherrif certify that  
 Edward Needles of said County, that came and proved to my satisfaction  
 that the bear hereof a black woman who calls herself Henry  
 Steel, and who is now about twenty eight years of age five  
 feet four and one half inches high - dark complexion - is the  
 identical person named in a manumission from James Michael  
 to sundry negroes, to be free from the date thereof which  
 is the 25<sup>th</sup> of Aug. 1807. which said man. was  
 duly acknowledged and recorded among the land  
 records of the County of, where the said Henry Steel  
 was raised. In testimony whereof the 21<sup>st</sup>
