I hereby certify, that Mrs. Nancy Smith of the County
and State aforesaid came and proved to my satisfaction
that the bearer hereof, a dark mulatto man named
John alias John Hercules, who is now about 29 years
of age, 6 feet, and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch high, has one
large scar near the first joint, and between that and
the second joint of the middle finger of his right hand,
some other scar between the first and second joints
of the fore finger of the same hand, both occasioned
by burns, was born free, and raised in the County &
State aforesaid.
