Telford late of the County of St. Marys negro, bearing date on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1802, the said man: to be free on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1811, which said manumission was duly acknowledged and enrolled among the said records of the County of St. Marys where the said negro Jeremiah was raised - In Testimony to this 24<sup>th</sup> day

Haddaway on the 7<sup>th</sup> of September 1807 and duly attested, acknowledged and enrolled among the said records of the County of Calvert where the said Isaac Williams was raised
