 aforesaid, previous to the birth of the said negro man named
 James Proctor as aforesaid - and that he the said James Proctor
 was born and raised in the County of Talbot aforesaid

 other, has a scar on his Chin and one on the right corner of his right
 eye, has several notable marks on his right hand and also the
 Letters P F stamped on his right arm, is the identical person
 manumitted by William Wendman in the year 1807
