Thomas Lewis of the County of Talbot in the year nineteen
hundred and ninety eight to be present at the execu-
tion of the year 1804 and was purchased by William
Henderson of the said County and was manumitted
by the said Henderson in November 1808 to be
free immediately at that time that is to say in
November 1808. Witness this 15th day of August 1804
