 to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof Negro Nancy  
 of a dark brown complexion five feet four inches  
 high has a remarkable scar on her left cheek and  
 sore from her left eye and also has a scar on her right  
 wrist is the identical person mentioned by Joseph  
 Jordan on the 8 day of December 1798 to be free  
 when she arrived to age of twenty one years which was on the  
 Year 1802 In Testimony Whereof I do this 18th 1802

State of Maryland Talbot County, Town of Easton I do hereby  
 certify to all whom it shall in any manner concern that Mrs  
 Nancy Faulkner wife of James Faulkner of the County  
 State of Maryland came before me to my satisfaction that the  
 bearer hereof a black man who calls himself David  
 who is about five feet six inches high and one eighth  
 of an inch high twenty seven years of age marked  
 with one pox on the forehead in a straight direction  
 over his right eye and nose is the identical person  
 named in a manumission from John Neely to Sunday  
 nee, which is duly recorded among the Land records  
 of Talbot County and that the said David was  
 raised in the said County State of Maryland In Testimony  
 the 20th of Dec. 1809
