feet ten inches, and three quarters of an inch high.  
Two small scars about the corner of her left eye -  
dark complexion is the identical person named  
in a charter made by the said William Wilson,  
to be free when she should arrive to the age of eighteen  
years, which said charter was duly executed and recorded  
among the Land records of the County & State aforesaid.
