shall hereafter concern  
doth or may concern that James Gellan  
of the County and State aforesaid came &  
proved to my Satisfaction, that the  
bearer hereof, (Negro Joseph, who is  
now about 27 years of age, 5 feet 6  
inches high, of a bright mulatto complexion,  
has no notable marks or scars, except  
a small scar on the back of his right  
hand, which he says was occasioned by the  
bite of a Dog at the same person named  
in the bill of entail (Wm. Brown, Sen.  
of the City & State aforesaid on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of  
August 1810, to be free & at liberty on the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 1815 then next  
following; which said bill was duly executed  
& acknowledged & enrolled among the land  
records of the City aforesaid where the said Negro  
Joseph was raised - In Testimony &c this 3<sup>rd</sup>
