Hereby certify to all persons whom it doth
or may concern that Andrew Crain of the County of
Carroll and proved to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof
a dark mulatto man, named Jack. five feet, five
and a half inches high, with a scar on his left arm
a little above his wrist, and a scar over his left eye,
about thirty years of age, was raised in the County
of Carroll, as the identical person mentioned by name
in the year Eighteen hundred, to be free on the
fifteenth day of May, eighteen hundred and ten.

of the County and State aforesaid came and proved
to my satisfaction that the bearer hereof a black man
who calls himself John Madden and who is now
about twenty three years of age, five feet seven inches

Scar near his right temple, ^{one other small Scar on his right eye brow} one other small Scar
on the forehead of his neck - also several small
Scars on ~~the~~ his hands, and rather of a bright Com-
plexion was born free, and that he was raised in the
County and State aforesaid -
