 the fore teeth of his under-jaw, and a
 small gap or space between the fore
 teeth of his upper jaw, is the identical
 person manumitted & set free by Mrs
 Catharine Gledborough on the 16th inst. which
 s^r. says James otherwise called James
 Dixon was raised in the County & State
