P. 17. 30<sup>th</sup>

State of Maryland - I hereby certify to all persons, Calbot County Court & whom it doth or may concern, that Samuel D., Darden of the County & state aforesaid, come & proved to my satisfaction that the Deaver here of Negro Oliver, 5 feet 8 inches high of a very dark complexion about 25 years of age, has a scar on the third joint of his fore finger on his right hand, also has a scar over each eye, is the identical person mentioned by John Dickinson late of Calbot County Decreed on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1804, to be free on the first day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1809, and was raised in the City of Baltimore in testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand & affixed the public seal of my office this 2<sup>d</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> Anno Domini 1809
