 Citizen of the County & State aforesaid came & proved  
 to my satisfaction, that the bearer hereof (Negro  
 Abraham, who is now about 21 Years of age, 5 ft.  
 6 in. high, of a black complexion, has  
 one scar on outer edge of his left hand, and  
 another partly on, or near the wrist; has another  
 scar in his forehead; has lost one of his upper  
 teeth, is the identical person manumitted  
 and set free by W. Lydia Kemp of Widow of  
 Jos. Kemp, of the County aforesaid.
