Thereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the aforesaid Solomon Riggini if he to answer ^{unto} and afterwards to wit the ^{ninth} day of March Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty six before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset now here held in the Court house at Dwidning Creek in the same County Coues the said Solomon Riggini in Custody of the Sheriff of Somerset in his proper person into whose Custody before that time was taken by the said Sheriff for the cause aforesaid and being by the said Sheriff Led to the Bar is Instantly demanded how he would acquitt himself of the Trespass and assault aforesaid by the Information aforesaid above upon him Imposed with that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of the trespass and assault aforesaid in manner & form aforesaid upon him Imposed & Wherupon all and singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood

It is Considered that the aforesaid Solomon Riggini pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland for his fine by the Court here upon him Imposed for and by reason of the trespass and assault aforesaid whole of his four aforesaid he is convicted five pounds Curr. money of Maryland and that the said Solomon Riggini be taken to Satisfie his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid whereupon the said Solomon Riggini is ordered to give Security for his good behaviour and appearance at June Court next Wherupon the said Solomon Riggini with the following Justices of Somerset County gave his Security both present herain Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of the province of Maryland in the Sum of Twenty pounds Sterling good and Lawfull money of England ^{Bank of} of their goods and Chattels Lands and tenements severally to the Use of the said Lord Proprietary his heirs & Successors to be made and Leased If it happen that the said Solomon Riggini do not make his personall appearance before the Justices of his said Lordship's County Court of Somerset ^{to be} held ^{at} the Court house at Dwidning Creek the third Tuesday June Next &c Do not answer unto his said Lordship of and Concerning such matters and things as shall be then and there objected against him on his said Lordship's behalfs Do not stay & abide the Judgment of the Court thereon & in the mean time if he is not of the good behaviour towards his said Lordship and all his good people and more especially towards the said Cornelius Dickerson & the said John Flemming's Security for fees &c
